
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Thing to know doing trade with Pakistan

Pakistan - Import Tariffs

- Pakistan uses the Harmonized System to classify goods.
- Pakistan's overall average applied tariff in 2016 was 12.71 percent.
- In the 2017 budget, the government reduced the maximum general tariff rate from 25 percent to 20 percent (except for vehicles) and simplified the tariff structure by reducing the number of duty brackets from seven to six.
- Other than customs duty, the government charges 17.0 percent sales tax on the duty paid value of a variety of goods produced in or imported into the country.

Pakistan - Trade Barriers

- Pakistan's 2016 Import Policy Order bans the import of 43 categories or products, mostly on religious, environmental, security, and health grounds.
- Pakistan also bans the import of live animals such as cattle, buffalo, sheep and goats, meat and bone meal, tallow containing protein and feed ingredients from any Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) affected countries.
- A previous ban on the import of live animals from the United States was lifted in 2015.
- Any dispute or clarifications regarding import status of any product which cannot be resolved by the Customs Authorities are referred to Ministry of Commerce for a final decision.

Pakistan - Labeling/Marking Requirements

- Pakistan has no uniform or universal system of imposing labeling and marking
 requirements on products.
- Individual industries or sectors are subject to the regulations of specific bodies. For example, the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulation and Coordination sets requirements for the pharmaceutical industry.
- The Ministry of Agriculture sets requirements for pesticides and edible products.



Azerbaijan imports decreased from \$9.17Billion to \$8.76 Billion in the year 2013-2017 with the percentage change of -19%. The key importer exporters to Azerbaijan are Russia, Turkey, China, United States of America, Ukraine and Germany. Total import value of Azerbaijan in 2017 was recorded (\$8,766,505,000). The key products that Azerbaijan imports are Machinery, Articles of iron, Electrical Machinery, Commodities, Vehicles, Mineral Fuels, & Cereals. Pakistan's exports to Azerbaijan increased from \$1.7M to \$6.1M in the year 2013-2017 with the percentage change of 259%. 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




